### About the Committee

The committee's goal is to add value to the Paramedic Chiefs of Canada by supporting and encouraging developing tools, processes, forums, research, and partnerships that enhance paramedicine's leadership across Canada. We work with international partners in promoting and furthering the leadership development of paramedic service leaders.

Over the past few years, the committee has developed the National Leadership Mentoring Program, the Paramedic Leadership Competency Framework, the Leadership Self-Assessment Tool, and other leadership development initiatives. These initiatives' success has created committee members' opportunities to share this work with other Canadian and international organizations. Our current initiative is the development of a national leadership development model.

#### Process

- 1. Expression of Interest is published nationally.
- 2. The current LDC will review applications.
  - a. Our goal is to ensure we add value to the committee and fill any skills or demographic gaps.
- 3. Applicants progressing forward will join the LDC on a teleconference for a leadership conversation.
- 4. The PCC executive will review the LDC recommendations and provide guidance and feedback.
- 5. Once the LDC receives affirmation regarding future member selection, an invitation letter will be sent to selected candidates to join the LDC.
